

END-USER LICENSE AGREEMENT

REVISED AUGUST 2009

NOTE: THIS LICENSE AGREEMENT IS AN ADDENDUM TO THE MAIN PURCHASE AGREEMENT. BY ENTERING INTO SUCH PURCHASE AGREEMENT, LOGGING ONTO THE CLIENT ADMINISTRATION WEBSITE, PUBLISHING CONTENT FOR USE WITHIN YOUR ORGANIZATION, ACCESSING THE *YOU MAKE THE CALL!*[®] (LICENSED WORK) SOFTWARE, WHETHER ONLINE, BY DISK, OR IN ANY OTHER FORMAT OR MAKING ANY OTHER USE THEREOF, YOU SHOW YOUR ACCEPTANCE OF THE TERMS OF THIS LICENSE AGREEMENT.

References to the Licensed Work shall apply to all programming and documentation of You Make the Call!, Inc. provided to Administrators, participants or any other agent or representative of Licensee. With the exception of the rights described in Section 1.0, making any derivative works at any time is strictly prohibited.

1. RIGHTS

1.1. Licensor hereby grants you a non-exclusive right and license:

- 1.1.1. to access the Licensed Work on computer systems owned, leased or otherwise controlled by your organization;
- 1.1.2. to access the web-hosted version of the Licensed Work via home computers;
- 1.1.3. to make copies of the Licensed Work in machine-readable form only for use only with employees of your company; and
- 1.1.4. to use the administrative portion of the Licensed Work to create scenarios and thereby customize *You Make the Call!* for such uses as you may select.

1.2. Any use, copying or distribution of the Licensed Work not authorized by this License Agreement shall automatically terminate your rights and license hereunder. This grant shall be limited to use of the Licensed Work with the equipment for which the Licensed Work is certified in Licensor's published specifications. Except as provided in subsection 1.1.2 above, use of the Licensed Work on processors accessible through communications networks through terminals and devices not on premises owned or controlled by you is prohibited unless otherwise agreed to in writing by Licensor.

2. LICENSOR'S PROPRIETARY INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY.

- 2.1. Licensor's Proprietary Property includes all intellectual property associated with *You Make the Call!*, including all software, formatting, documentation, training materials, domain names, trademarks, and any improvements to same. Licensee agrees that Licensor's Proprietary Intellectual Property is the sole property of Licensor and that Licensor will at all times retain sole and exclusive title to and ownership thereof. Except as expressly provided above, nothing contained in this Agreement or otherwise shall be construed to grant to Licensor any right, title, license or other interest in, to or under any Licensor Proprietary Intellectual Property.
- 2.2. The Licensed Work contains substantial intellectual property and trade secrets of Licensor, and you agree that your organization shall employ reasonable security precautions to maintain the confidentiality of such intellectual property and trade secrets. As to any system information furnished to you, you agree that your organization shall at all times prevent disclosure or dissemination of the trade secrets embodied therein to any person, firm, organization, or employee, except as necessary to exercise the rights granted to you hereunder, provided such person, firm, organization or employee has agreed to comply with the terms of this License Agreement with regard to trade secrets. You agree that no one within your organization or to whom your organization has provided the Licensed Work will unlock, decompile, decode or in any way reverse-engineer the Licensed Work.
- 2.3. Licensor claims and reserves all rights and benefits afforded under federal and international copyright law in all programming and documentation comprising the Licensed Work as copyrighted works. With any copy of the Licensed Work delivered by your organization to its employees, Licensee shall include the copyright notices and

proprietary legends as they appear in the Licensed Work and on the media containing the Licensed Work supplied hereunder.

3. FEES AND PAYMENTS

- 3.1. The Licensee must purchase a license for and register the name, email address, and phone number of any individual (“Named Administrator”) who will be given access to create, edit, publish or delete sessions through the *You Make the Call!* web-hosted administration tool. Identification of Named Administrators must be unique, and registered licenses may not be shared or used by anyone other than the employee to whom the Named Administrator license is registered. Named Administrators must be identified on the *You Make the Call!* Order Form.
- 3.2. In the event a Named Administrator no longer requires access to the administration tool, the Licensee may remove the Named Administrator from the registration maintained by Licensor and may transfer the license registration to another employee by providing Licensor the name, email address and phone number of the new Named Administrator. At that time, new logon credentials will be assigned and provided to the customer.

4. WARRANTY

- 4.1. Licensor warrants that the Licensed Work will be in good working order and will conform in all material respects to Licensor’s published specifications for so long as Licensor possesses paid licenses. Licensor does not warrant that the operation of the Licensed Work will be uninterrupted or error-free, or that the software functions will meet your individualized requirements. Licensor shall, as its exclusive remedy for any nonconformity in the Licensed Work, repair or replace (at its option) the Licensed Work with a conforming version thereof or, if Licensor is unable to provide such a conforming version, refund the fees paid to Licensor.
- 4.2. The foregoing warranty does not cover repair for damages, malfunctions or service failures caused by (1) actions of any non-Licensor personnel; (2) failure to follow Licensor’s instructions for operation maintenance; (3) attachment to or incorporation in the Licensed Work of non-Licensor products not supported by Licensor; or (4) any factor beyond Licensor’s control including fire, explosion, lightning, pest damage, power surges or failures, strikes or labor disputes, water, acts of God, the elements, war, civil disturbances, acts of civil or military authorities or the public enemy, inability to secure raw materials, transportation facilities, fuel or energy shortages or acts or omissions of communications carriers.
- 4.3. EXCEPT AS STATED IN THIS ARTICLE, LICENSOR AND ITS AFFILIATES, SUBCONTRACTORS AND REPRESENTATIVES MAKE NO WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, AND SPECIFICALLY DISCLAIM OTHER WARRANTIES, INCLUDING (WITHOUT LIMITATION) ANY WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.
- 4.4. YOU AGREE THAT YOUR SOLE REMEDY AGAINST LICENSOR, ITS AFFILIATES, SUBCONTRACTORS AND REPRESENTATIVES FOR LOSS OR DAMAGE CAUSED BY ANY DEFECT OR FAILURE OF THE LICENSED WORK, REGARDLESS OF THE FORM OF ACTION, WHETHER IN CONTRACT OR TORT, INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE, STRICT LIABILITY OR OTHERWISE, SHALL BE EITHER (1) THE REPAIR OR REPLACEMENT OF THE LICENSED WORK OR (2) IF SUCH REPAIR CANNOT BE MADE OR AN EQUIVALENT REPLACEMENT CANNOT BE PROVIDED, THE REFUND OF AMOUNTS PREVIOUSLY PAID BY YOU.

5. LIABILITY LIMITS

- 5.1. IN NO EVENT SHALL LICENSOR BE LIABLE FOR INCIDENTAL, INDIRECT, SPECIAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES OR FOR LOST PROFITS, SAVINGS, OR REVENUES OF ANY KIND OR FOR LOST DATA OR DOWNTIME, WHETHER OR NOT LICENSOR HAS BEEN ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF THE DAMAGE.
- 5.2. THE CUMULATIVE LIABILITY OF LICENSOR TO YOUR ORGANIZATION FOR ALL CLAIMS RELATING TO THE LICENSED WORK OR THIS LICENSE AGREEMENT, REGARDLESS OF THE FORM OR ACTION, WHETHER IN CONTRACT OR TORT, INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE, STRICT LIABILITY OR OTHERWISE, SHALL NOT EXCEED THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF ALL FEES PAID TO LICENSOR HEREUNDER.

6. MISCELLANEOUS

- 6.1. All terms and conditions of this Agreement shall remain in effect for so long as you access or execute the Licensed Work or otherwise make any use of the licensed work. Thereafter, the provisions of Articles 2 through 6 hereof shall continue to apply in accordance with their terms, notwithstanding the termination of your license.
- 6.2. This Agreement shall inure to the benefit of, and be binding on, your organization and Licensor, and their respective successors and assigns. You may not assign this Agreement except to a successor to all or substantially all of the business and properties of your organization dealing with the Licensed Work.
- 6.3. References to “your organization” or “you” herein, for the purposes of establishing the permitted use of the Licensed Work, shall include the operations of any direct or indirect parent or subsidiary company or of any direct or indirect subsidiary company of any such parent company.
- 6.4. This License Agreement and the rights and obligations of the parties with respect to the Licensed Work shall be governed by North Carolina law, and the state and federal courts in Wake County, North Carolina are the proper and sole venue for litigating such disputes.

YOU ACKNOWLEDGE THAT YOU HAVE READ THIS AGREEMENT AND UNDERSTAND IT AND THAT BY ENTERING INTO THE PURCHASE, INSTALLING OR EXECUTING THE LICENSED WORK, OR MAKING ANY OTHER USE OF IT, YOU AGREE TO BE BOUND BY ITS TERMS AND CONDITIONS. YOU FURTHER AGREE THAT, EXCEPT FOR SEPARATE WRITTEN AGREEMENTS BETWEEN LICENSOR AND YOU, THIS AGREEMENT IS THE COMPLETE AND EXCLUSIVE STATEMENT OF THE RIGHTS AND LIABILITIES OF THE PARTIES.
